Keep informed of the latest Covid-19 announcements, restrictions and requirements before each trip. Ensure that your tour guides and drivers are well trained in Covid-19 safety; and they understand their roles and responsibilities implementing all of the measures which your company and the community are taking to reduce risks to tourists, community members and your staff



Always book tours and community based tourism (CBT) in advance. Do not expect communities to be able to manage last minute bookings or unannounced visits



Provide your tour guides or drivers with plenty of hand sanitizer and face masks in case tourists have forgotten or lost theirs



Prepare a waste bin with a lid so that personal waste can be removed from the community (e.g. tissues, face masks, water bottles). Prepare a specific, clearly marked area for this bin, and then dispose of the waste safely and carefully. Do not leave this waste for the community to manage





Be prepared for an emergency: Check the location of the community quarantine area in case tourists or tour guides are suspected of being sick with Covid-19 symptoms. Make sure you have planned arrangements and set specific routes to pick up and transport sick people from the quarantine area to the most appropriate hospital (identified in your Covid-19 safety plan)
