COVID-19 SAFETY GUIDELINES FOR COMMUNITY TOURS

COVID-19 SAFETY recommendations for

LOCAL VILLAGE COMMITTEE AND/OR CBT MANAGERS*

*These are guidelines for local community members who are coordinating a village tour / CBT



Identify a suitable area, outside and away from crowded areas, which can be used as a community quarantine area in case tourists or tour guides suffer from Covid-19 symptoms while they are in the village. This area will be used while tourists or their tour guides arrange how to evacuate to the nearest hospital. Seating and shade should be prepared in the guarantine area



Keep a simple checklist of important actions which always need to be taken before and after you receive visitors (e.g. disinfecting surfaces, washing hands, etc.). Keep a written record of who takes these actions and at what time

Ensure that all village service providers understand and have practiced how to deliver their services safely: with sufficient physical distancing, masks and hygiene practices in place. Surfaces and objects which are touched frequently during the visit should be identified and cleaned before and after each trip, with soap and water, or another suitable cleaning product



Only accept tourists who have booked in advance. Ask the licensed tour guides who accompany tourists to your community to provide a list of each visitors' name and nationality when they arrive. If there is an emergency, make a detailed written record of any actions which you took



Tourists, tour guides and drivers must not enter villagers' homes or other enclosed buildings. All experiences in the village (e.g. artisan demonstrations, lunches) must only be conducted outside
