Plan and inform local authorities and the community about the trip as far in advance as possible. Before departing for the community, check tourists' temperatures and confirm with each tourist that they do not have any Covid-19 symptoms (e.g. cough, fever, loss of taste and smell)



Before departing, check that all tourists have their own masks and hand sanitizer. Brief tourists on what will happen when they arrive, and divide into smaller groups of 5 people if necessary



On arrival and during the village visit, actively raise Covid-19 prevention awareness among community members and village guides as much as possible. In particular, actively and politely support local community tour guides to explain any Covid-19 guidelines clearly and effectively, and to manage tourists' and community members' safety as necessary. Remember to respect a larger physical distancing than other people, since it is recommended to keep up to 7 metres of distance in situations when people speak loudly and can produce droplets



If a tourist experiences symptoms in the village (fever, cough, loss of smell and taste), separate them immediately from other tourists and community members. Go directly to the designated community quarantine area. Contact the closest health centre or hospital, and travel there in the quickest and safest way possible



After the trip, keep visitors information and contact details for a minimum of 3 weeks. This information will be used to contact tourists in the event that someone in the group develops Covid-19 symptoms, and their travel companions need to be contacted to have a Covid-19 test
